Our family database is now at 8,392individuals, an increase of 649 people since the last newsletter. This is a very large increase that is due mostly to my completing an Internet search on about 3,000 names in the database, which turned up many new details, many of which came from obituaries and other researchers databases. We also had good luck using Ancestry.com and GenealogyBank.com, which was very useful for finding obituaries.

Our country-recording artist cousin, **Dan Colehour** of Nashville, TN, has been touring in the last year, playing frequently in the Upper Midwest, including many minor league baseball stadiums. We had the opportunity to see him play three different times and he puts on a very good show, mostly playing tunes that he has written. He released a CD in 2007.

Mike Colehour of Minnetonka, MN was inducted into the Augsburg College (MN) Athletic Hall of Fame in September 2008. In three seasons of hockey at Augsburg, he scored 37 goals with 30 assists for 67 career points. In the national title season of 1977-78, Mike scored 25 goals with 15 assists for 40 points, earning All-MIAC and NAIA All-American honors. He was a part of two MIAC title teams (1976-77, 1977-78) and three NAIA national tournament squads. His niece, **Karen Colehour** of Schnectady, NY, has helped Elmira College to the number one ranking in Division III women's hockey, as of press time.

In this issue we will discuss the descendants of **Charles Krozer Gayleard**. He was first mentioned in our year 2000 newsletter. He was the son of **Noah Gayleard and Rachel Ann Colhouer**, grandson of **Frederick Jacob Colhouer**.
